The School Program is an essential part of supporting young students with developmental disabilities to find success in their formative years of school. The **Elementary School Teacher** will work with a transdisciplinary team to provide a positive classroom environment while meeting individual children's needs and working in a child-focused, family-centered environment. At Children's Autism Services of Edmonton, we provide family-centered services within the home, school or community to meet the complex needs of children who have autism and other developmental disorders using the SCERTS® Model.

Key Responsibilities:

- Develop implement and monitor classroom activities to meet the needs of individual students
- Develop/review and implement Individual Program Plans (IPP) in collaboration with parents and consultants and lead IPP meetings
- Complete formative and summative assessments of student progress and create reports to share with families (e.g. report cards)
- Participate in professional growth opportunities
- Work collaboratively on a team of professionals which may include speech and language pathologists, occupational therapists, behavior consultants, registered dietitians and psychologists
- Incorporate recommendations and strategies provided by consultants into classroom activities and daily routines and provide feedback on the recommendations
- Supervise and coach classroom educational assistants

Required Qualifications:

- 3+ years of direct experience in a special needs setting or equivalent
- Bachelor's of Education and valid Alberta Teaching Certificate are required
- Police Check with Vulnerable Sector
- Child Intervention Record Check Required
- Safe Management Training (Provided), CPR and Standard First Aid certification required
